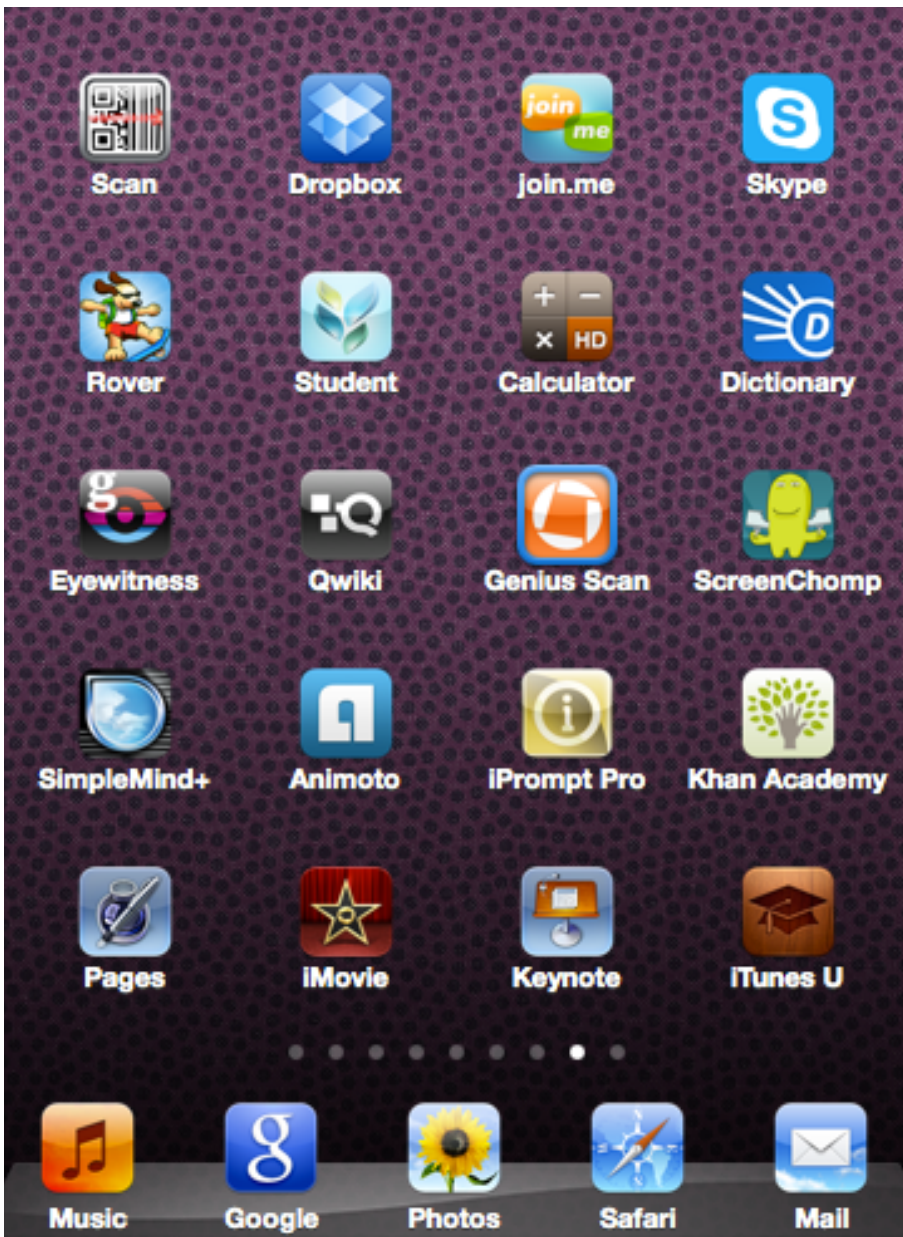

***Skype** — Call, video call, or instant message with anyone else on Skype.

Rover — Streaming educational Flash software on your iPad.

***Student** — The student response system for Socrative.

Calculator — The calculator is not a standard app on the iPad, so pick one that has the features you are looking for.

***Dictionary** — A fully functioning online dictionary. Includes a thesaurus.

Eyewitness — The most stunning photos in the world, providing a daily reflection of world events.

***Quiki** — Explore the world in which you live. Contains over 3,000,000 topics of interest.

JotNot — Use your camera to scan documents as a PDF or JPG.

ScreenChomp — "Record it. Sketch it. Share it."

SimpleMind+ — A mind mapping tool to create thinking maps.

Animoto — Easily turn your photos into high quality videos set to music.

iPromptPro — Turn your iPad into a teleprompter.
